

# STATUE OF LIBERTY STAND-UP FIGURE

**DIRECTIONS:** 1. If paper is white, color it first; 2. Cut out on the dark outer lines; 3. Apply glue, or use tape, to fasten edges.

**AS YOU CREATE:** Think about what liberty, the concept, and Liberty, the statue, is made of.
