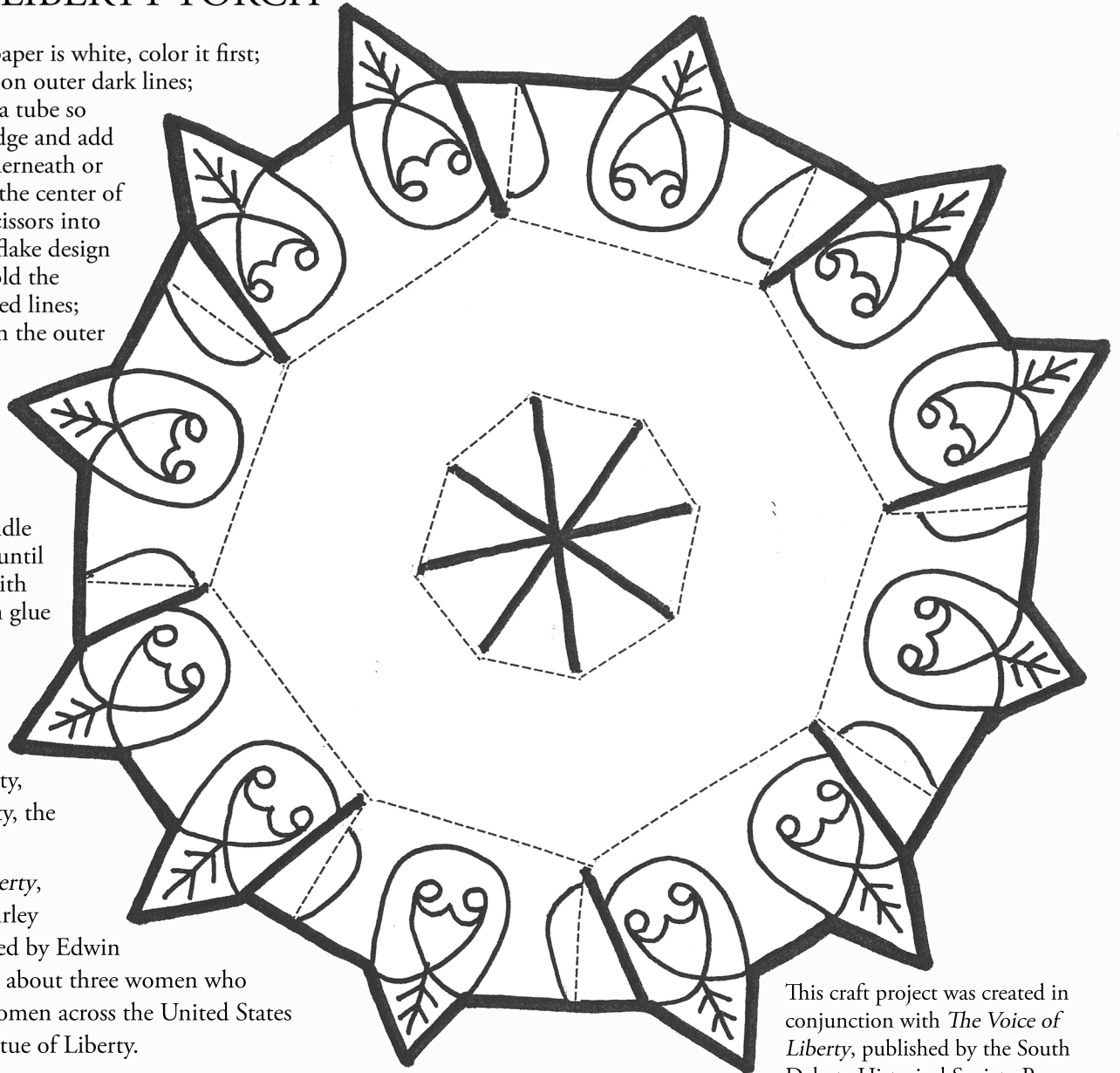


STATUE OF LIBERTY TORCH

DIRECTIONS: 1. If paper is white, color it first;
2. Cut out both pieces on outer dark lines;
3. Roll up handle into a tube so arrows meet. Lift the edge and add a small line of glue underneath or tape; 4. Poke a hole in the center of the torch base, insert scissors into hole, and cut the snowflake design on the dark lines; 5. Fold the triangles up to the dotted lines;
6. Cut the dark lines on the outer edge and then fold all of the pieces at the dotted lines downwards; 7. Glue or tape the small triangle tabs behind the section next to it; 8. Insert handle down through the top until top of handle is even with the torch base and then glue or tape the triangles to the handle



AS YOU CREATE:

Think about what liberty, the concept, and Liberty, the statue, is made of.
